Dear Parents and Carers,

We hope that you have had a lovely, restful summer! I'm sure that many children (and parents!) will be keen to get back into a routine again and we can't wait to welcome you back. For some parents this may be the first time sending your child to school, so we want to reassure you that they are going to have a wonderful year, so please try not to worry!

In Tiger class Miss Salter will be the class teacher and in Giraffe class Miss Dennis will be the class teacher.

We will have several teaching assistants working in Reception this year: Mrs Polski- Delve, Miss Scott, Miss Lemmon and Miss Preston. We will also be having other adults from within school join us to listen to the children read.

We will be having free flow in the classrooms and so the children will get to spend time with all of the teachers, teaching assistants and children in both classes.

Below, we have provided an overview of the curriculum for the Autumn term and some other useful information but do ask if you would like any further details and keep an eye on our reception page on the school website, which will be updated shortly. We look forward to meeting you all again on Monday 9th September. We will be on the playground from around 8:35am to come and greet the children and take them in for their first day.

Home visits

We look forward to meeting with you again at your home visit. If you are not sure when your appointment is please contact your child's class teacher by email to arrange this. You will receive a free book bag for your child on this visit.

Children in Giraffe class and Tiger class will be starting school on Monday 9th September following home visits.

Start and finish times:

Monday and Tuesday will be 8:40am- 11:45am (no lunch)

Wednesday, Thursday and Friday will be 8:40am- 1:30pm (with lunch)

The week beginning 16th September, children will be in school full time: 8:40am- 3:15pm.

Please can children wait on the playground near the yellow reception gate at drop off.

PE- Our PE sessions will be on a Wednesday for both tigers and giraffes so children will need to come to school in PE kits on those days.

General reminders

Children should bring in their own water bottle to keep in class which they can access throughout the day. Please make sure your child's name is written clearly on their water bottle and that the water is changed regularly.

Children will continue order their lunch in the morning at registration; it is helpful if the children have looked at and discussed the menu at home in the morning if ordering a school lunch!

It would be great if you can send in a pair of wellies with your child. Ideally these are best kept in school for the year, as it means we are always prepared for play outside, even on more drizzly days!

Please ensure that your child has a couple of spare changes of clothes, including underwear and socks, to keep in school just in case.

Please bring in your child's book bag every day. We will put letters and paperwork to go home in there.
