General Reminders

- Children should bring in their own **water bottle** to keep in class which they can access throughout the day. Please make sure your child's name is written clearly on their water bottle and that the water is changed regularly.
- Please ensure ALL clothing and equipment are named, especially jumpers, cardigans and even shoes. We had a lot of lost property last year.
- Children will continue to order their **lunch** in the morning at registration; **it is helpful if the children have looked at and discussed the menu at home in the morning if ordering a school lunch!** The Spring/Summer menu continues into October. [Lunch menu](#)
- It would be great if you can send in a pair of **wellies** with your child. Ideally these are best kept in school for the year, as it means we are always prepared for play outside, even on more drizzly days!
- Please ensure that your child has a **spare change of clothes, including underwear and socks**, to keep in school just in case of accidents.

Our Autumn term curriculum

Maths - we begin our Maths scheme ('Maths no Problem') which is used throughout the school from year 1. In the Autumn term, this covers numbers to 10 then 20 (including addition and subtraction bonds), position, shape and pattern.

Phonics - we continue with the 'Little Wandle' phonics scheme begun in Reception. Details for this term are on the website.

English - Writing adventure stories based on the book Lost and Found by Oliver Jeffers and writing diary entries.

Geography - introducing maps, including simple map making of our new classroom and the building.

History - personal chronologies (comparing the 'timelines' of children's lives to older people). Later in the term, we will be requesting photos from every/some year (s) of your child's life, if possible!

Science - we begin our 'Seasonal Changes' unit by looking at Autumn. Feel free to send any interesting Autumnal items from nature that you may find!

PE - multiskills, then gymnastics

RE - what do Christians believe that God is like?
